What is the Toronto Power Generating Station?

The Toronto Power Generating Station is a landmark facility that significantly influenced the evolution of energy infrastructure in Toronto and the surrounding region. Built near Niagara Falls, it was the first large-scale power station in the area, heralding a new era of industrial progress.

How many watts can a Toronto Power Station produce?

Designed to provide Toronto with now-defunct 25 cycle power, the Toronto Power Generating Station was equipped with a wheel pit 120-m (400-ft) long and 45-m (150-ft) deep with 11 turbines. Initially, the station could produce more than 8,000,000 watts of electricity; after years of development, it had the capacity to produce over 100,000,000 watts.

The plant is located at 440 Unwin Avenue in Toronto's Port Lands area, directly south of the foot of Carlaw Avenue, across the shipping channel and next to the recently opened Portlands Energy Centre.
